Expressions of interest

The Republic of Serbia has received financing in the amount of 275,2 million EUR from the World Bank toward the cost of the Corridor X Highway Project, and intends to apply part of the proceeds for consultant services to improve road safety management in Serbia. The assignment will be managed by the Project Implementing Entity, Koridor 10, Limited Liability Company (K10DOO).

The primary objective of the assignment is to provide technical assistance to the Government of the Republic of Serbia to strengthen its road traffic safety management capacity and develop a comprehensive results-focused road safety strategy.

The secondary objectives of the assignment have been identified as the following:

- Build capacity within the key road safety stakeholders (Ministry of Infrastructure, Ministry of Interior, Ministry of Health, Ministry of Justice, Ministry of Education, Public Enterprise “Roads of Serbia”, Road Traffic Safety Agency) for achievement of accountable performance over the medium to long term and sustainable road safety management framework;
- Upgrade/improve existing road crash data bases and access to licensing/vehicle registration data bases;
- Agree and measure intermediate indicators of road safety performance on the network.

The implementation period is 18 (eighteen) months.

The K10DOO now invites eligible consultancy firms to indicate their interest in providing the services. Interested consultants are requested to provide information indicating their suitability to perform the services (brochures, description of experience of firm in similar assignments, experience in similar conditions, availability, experience in the region, etc). Consultants may associate to enhance their qualifications by forming joint ventures. In the case of joint venture member in-charge should be identified along with other members. Joint ventures should submit letters of intent indicating their intent to form a joint venture if awarded the contract and shall provide the above mentioned information for each member of the joint venture.

A consultant will be selected in accordance with the procedures for Quality and Cost Based Selection (QCBS) method set out in the World Bank’s Guidelines: Selection and Employment of Consultants by World Bank Borrowers (May 2004, revised October 1, 2006).
